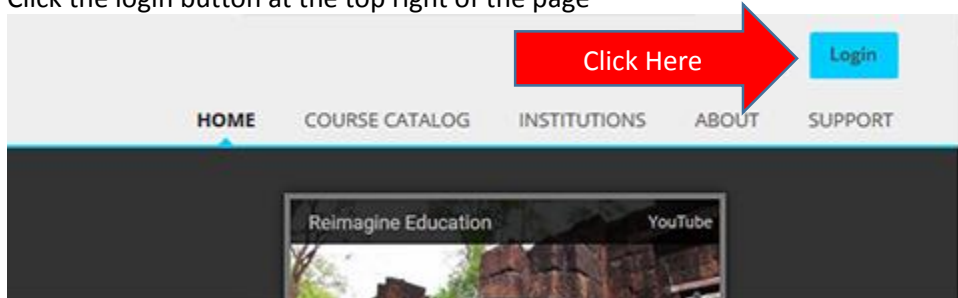
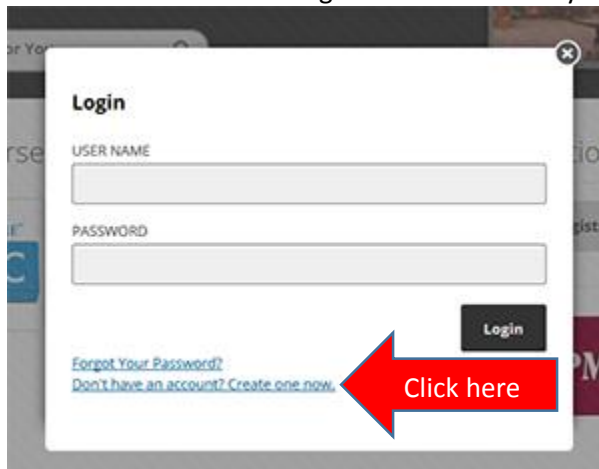


## Instructions for Accessing the International Students Pre-Arrival Orientation Modules


1. Go to <https://openeducation.blackboard.com>
2. Click the login button at the top right of the page




3. At the bottom of the dialog box is a link that says: "Don't have an account? Create one now"

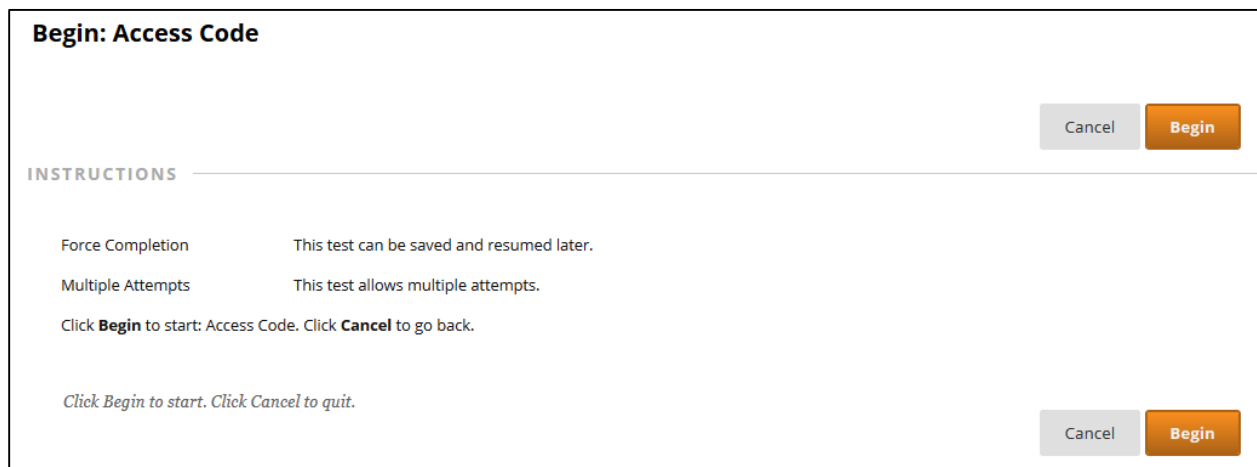
12. Once inside of the course, begin by clicking "start here" on the left navigation panel.
